#### **REGISTER FOR OUR MAY LUNCH BUNCH**



#### TONY'S REFLECTION RECOGNIZING JESUS IN THE BREAKING OF THE BREAD

What makes Jesus unique from the other religious leaders that have appeared on the world stage over the centuries? Last week, we saw that, unlike Buddha, Mohammed, or Zarathustra, Jesus physically rose from the dead appearing and talking to his followers at length. In this Sunday's Gospel, we encounter another instance of Jesus' uniqueness – the fact that His suffering and Resurrection were strikingly foreshadowed by the sacred prophets of Israel. That is, hundreds of years before His birth, the prophets predicted in advance Jesus' ending for all to watch.

In the Mass, we proclaim in the Creed: "For our sake, He was crucified under Pontius Pilate, He suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures." The inclusion of this all-important phrase acts as a spotlight to draw our attention to the fact that Jesus' Passion and Resurrection fulfilled the oracles of the prophets is central to the Gospel message.

In the Gospel scene today, we find Jesus nonchalantly strolling along two disciples from Jerusalem to Emmaus acting like He's not privy to the dramatic news of Easter Sunday. Grieving Jesus' death on the long walk, Cleopas and his companion do not initially recognize the Man walking beside them and attempt to teach Jesus all about Himself. As we all do, these disciples begin to blunder their teaching of the whole point of Christianity. After they clearly botch their evangelization effort, Jesus begins to reveal that, if not the Messiah, He is at least a Scripture scholar of the first order. Here, Jesus proceeds through the Old Testament explaining the key passages that prophesied His ministry. Talk about participating in the ultimate Bible study led by Jesus.

After this invigorating lesson, the disciples press Jesus to stay with them for the night. He agrees and at the evening meal, he "takes, blesses, breaks, and gives" the bread to those present. Here, Luke employs this same sequence of four verbs in his account of the feeding of the 5,000 and at the institution of the Eucharist. This helps us to understand the significance of their "recognition" of Jesus. Jesus didn't merely vanish from their sight but is rather now in the very bread He just took, blessed, broke, and gave. This serves as a holy lesson for us - we should "recognize" Jesus in the broken bread. There is no need to seek an obscure apparition of Jesus because He is truly present with us in the Eucharist.

To this day, the Emmaus Road scene eloquently presents us with the ideal form of Mass. First, there is the exposition of the Scriptures (Liturgy of the Word) as they walk along, then there is the intimate encounter with Him in the breaking of the bread (Liturgy of the Eucharist). May this gospel grant us the same burning hearts as those two disciples. And may we truly recognize Him in the Eucharist as those disciples two thousand years ago.
